Additional services offered on the same day as surgery:

- Microchips \$10
- Post-op pain meds for dogs over 10 pounds: \$10
- Post-op pain meds for cats and small dogs less than 9 pounds: \$8
- Rabies vaccine: \$5
- Canine Distemper/Parvo vaccine (DHPP): \$10
- Canine Influenza: \$20*
- Feline Distemper vaccine (FVRCP): \$8
- Canine Bordetella: \$10
- Canine Heartworm Testing: \$15
- Feline Leukemia and AIDS (FELV/FIV) Testing: \$25
- Nail trim \$2
- Cardboard carrier \$5

No other veterinary services, vaccines, or testing will be offered.

Vaccines, testing, and microchips will only be given to animals on their scheduled date of surgery. We cannot accept walk in clients for these services. You will be asked to sign an increased risk form if your animal receives vaccines on the same morning of surgery in case of allergic reaction to vaccines while under anesthesia.
